

Covered Sand Flowers

Create **colorful** and beautiful flowers and at the same time take care of our environment by recycling what we don't need any more! But how is this possible? ...

You can find out how by using the following supplies:

- 1.-Empty plastic bottles-(water, soda, juice, etc.)
- 2.-Glue
- 3.-Scissors
- 4.-Calcium Sand (item # 26137) our product
- 5.-Nerita Yellow Tiny (item # 53188) our product
Metallic Dyed Theodoxus (item # 85288) our product
Dyed Tiny Trochus (item # 28998) our product

Step1 Draw flower petals around the plastic bottle. Holding the bottle upside down by the bottle cap.

Step 2 Use the scissors to cut around at the top of the flower to separate the bottle. Then start cutting the flower shape by following the lines of the petals. After that, on the center of the flower pull each petal down forming the flower.

Step 3 Spread glue on each petal and sprinkle the *calcium sand* on it.

Step 4 Fill the center with tissue paper applying glue on it. Then start gluing the *nerita yellow tiny* or *metallic theodoxus* or the *dyed tiny trochus*, forming a pretty center.

Now you have a different kind of flower with beautiful sand colors. You can adorn your bedroom; by gluing a little piece of string on the back, your grandma's patio; by gluing a stick on the back or the refrigerator; by gluing a magnet on the back. Also it can be used as a beautiful gift for a loved one.
